'Leveraging artificial intelligence (AI) for Indian Navy'

(By Press Information Bureau)

Indian Navy's premier technical training institute INS Valsura organised a workshop on the contemporary topic 'Leveraging Artificial Intelligence (AI) for Indian Navy' from 19 to 21 Jan 2022. Conducted under the aegis of Southern Naval Command, speakers from renowned IT Companies like Google, IBM, Infosys and TCS shared the industry perspective during the three-day event. Distinguished academicians from IIT Delhi, New York University, Amrita University and DA-IICT also spoke about the latest trends and applications of AI. The keynote address was delivered by Vice Admiral MA Hampiholi, Flag Officer Commanding in Chief, Southern Naval Command who stressed on the strategic importance of this niche technology and its application in the Indian Navy. The webinar conducted saw online participation by over 500 participants from across the country. Indian Navy is focused on incorporation of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Machine Learning (ML) in critical mission areas. Located at Jamnagar, INS Valsura has already been designated as the Centre of Excellence (CoE) in the field of Big Data and a state of art lab on AI and Big Data Analysis (BDA) was set up in Jan 2020. The Navy is currently in the process of creating a Centre of Excellence (CoE) in the field of AI at INS Valsura, which has been instrumental in progress of pilot projects pertaining to adoption of AI and BDA in the domain of maintenance, HR and perception assessment, in collaboration with academia and industry. In addition, the Navy is deeply involved in unifying and reorganising its enterprise data, as data is the fuel for all AI engines.

Early signs of COVID-19 case plateauing reported but need to be observed, says govt.

New Delhi, Jan 28 (IPA) : Early indications of Covid infections plateauing have been reported in some places but the trend needs to be observed, the Union government said on Thursday whilst noting that 400 districts have logged weekly COVID positivity of over 10%. Stressing the need to continue with precautions to curb the surge in infections, it noted that Karnataka, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, Andhra Pradesh, Rajasthan were recording a high number of COVID-19 cases. However, a decrease in COVID cases and positivity rate have been observed in Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh, Delhi,

Odisha, Haryana and West Bengal, the government stated. Addressing a press conference in New Delhi, Lav Agarwal, the joint secretary in the Health Ministry said, "A clear trend in terms of fewer COVID cases requiring oxygen-supported beds or ICU beds has been observed." "Also, active COVID-19 cases and corresponding deaths are much lower during the present wave compared to earlier surges," he said. Warning against any lax in observing COVID-appropriate behaviour, Mr. Agarwal said 400 districts have reported over 10 per cent weekly COVID positivity while in 141 districts it was be-

tween five to 10% in the week ending January 26. About the prevalence of the Omicron variant of coronavirus in India, he said, 1,292 cases of the latest variant of concern were found on genome sequencing in December which rose to 9,672 in January. The top 10 states in terms of active Covid cases were contributing over 77% of total active infections in the country, Mr. Agarwal said, adding 11 states have over 50,000 active Covid cases while Karnataka, Maharashtra and Kerala have over 3 lakh active infections. In response to a question, he said, "Early indications of COVID cases

plateauing have been reported in some places but the trend needs to be observed and precautions need to be continued." About the vaccine coverage, the press conference was informed that 97.03 lakh healthcare, frontline workers and comorbid people aged 60 and above have been given the precaution dose of COVID vaccine. Also, 59% of adolescents in the 15-18 year age group have so far received the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine. The health ministry stressed that vaccination is providing support in terms of fewer cases, fewer hospitalizations and less severity in COVID-19 cases.

250 Tiwa, Gorkha extremists give up arms in Assam

Guwahati on Thursday. The organisations are the Tiwa Liberation Army (TLA) and the United Gorkha People's Organisation (UGPO). Formed in 2014 to cater to the aspirations of the Tiwa community, the

TLA was active in the Morigaon, Nagaon and West Karbi Anglong districts of central Assam. The UGPO, formed in 2007, was mostly active in the Bodoland Territorial Region and the Biswanath district.

New Delhi, Jan 28 (IPA) : Undaunted by the prospect of taking on Yogi Adityanath in his stronghold, Azad Samaj Party president Chandra Shekhar Aazad says the people of Gorakhpur will repeat the history of 1971 when a chief minister of Uttar Pradesh lost elections to the BJP so that there is no division between opposition. When they did not want to give us our share, we refused," Aazad said. He also rejected allegations of being a vote cutter and cleared the air about his fallout with the Akhilesh Yadav-led party. "I am saying SP is also doing its job and so are we. I have no problem with the SP," said the 36-year-old who has emerged as a prominent Dalit face.
